



## **INDEPENDENT LIMITED ASSURANCE STATEMENT**

**To: The Stakeholders of CVS Health**

### **Introduction and objectives of work**

Apex Companies, LLC (Apex) was engaged by CVS Health to provide limited assurance of its water usage data. This Assurance Statement applies to the Subject Matter included within the scope of work described below.

### **Scope of Work and Period Covered by Assurance**

The scope of our work was limited to assurance over water usage reported by CVS Health for the period January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025 (the 'Subject Matter').

### **Reporting Boundaries**

The reporting boundaries included:

- Operational Control as defined by the World Resources Institute (WRI)/World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD) Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Standard
- Worldwide locations for which CVS has reported water data or reported square footage (9,620 out of 9,739 locations)

### **Reporting Criteria**

The Subject Matter was prepared in accordance with the CVS Health Water Inventory Management Plan for the Reporting Year 2025. CVS Health reports water usage for (potable) water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH), cafeterias, integrated fire mitigation systems and irrigation.

### **Limitations and Exclusions**

Excluded from the scope of our work is any assurance of information relating to activities outside the defined assurance period.

Water use associated with 119 sites for which CVS does not have reported water data or reported square footage is excluded from the inventory.

This limited assurance engagement relies on a risk based selected sample of water data and the associated limitations that this entails. This independent assurance engagement and statement should not be relied upon to detect all errors, omissions or misstatements that may exist.

### **Responsibilities**

The preparation and presentation of the Subject Matter in the Report are the sole responsibility of the management of CVS Health.

Apex was not involved in the drafting of the Subject Matter or of the Reporting Criteria. Our responsibilities were to:

- obtain limited assurance about whether the Subject Matter has been prepared in accordance with the Reporting Criteria;
- form an independent conclusion based on the assurance procedures performed and evidence obtained; and
- report our conclusions to the stakeholders of CVS Health.

### **Assessment Standards**

We performed our work in accordance with Apex's standard procedures and guidelines for external Assurance of Sustainability Reports and International Standard on Assurance Engagements (ISAE) 3000 Revised, Assurance Engagements Other than Audits or Reviews of Historical Financial Information (effective for assurance reports dated on or after Dec. 15, 2015), issued by the International Auditing and Assurance Standards Board. A materiality threshold of  $\pm 5$ -percent was set for the assurance process.

**Summary of Work Performed**

As part of our independent verification, our work included:

- Assessing the appropriateness of the Reporting Criteria for the Subject Matter;
- Conducting interviews with relevant personnel of CVS Health and their consultant;
- Reviewing the data collection and consolidation processes used to compile Subject Matter, including assessing assumptions made and the data scope and reporting boundaries;
- Reviewing documentary evidence provided by CVS Health and their consultant;
- Agreeing a selection of the Subject Matter to the corresponding source documentation;
- Reviewing CVS Health systems for quantitative data aggregation and analysis; and
- Assessing the disclosure and presentation of the Subject Matter to ensure consistency with assured information.

**Reported Data**

The total water usage reported by CVS Health within the defined boundary was 6,457 megaliters.

Data and information supporting the reported water withdrawal were in most cases historical in nature, but in some cases estimated.

**Conclusion**

On the basis of our methodology and the activities described above:

- Nothing has come to our attention to indicate that the Subject Matter is not fairly stated in all material respects; and
- It is our opinion that CVS Health has established appropriate systems for the collection, aggregation and analysis of quantitative data associated with water usage.
