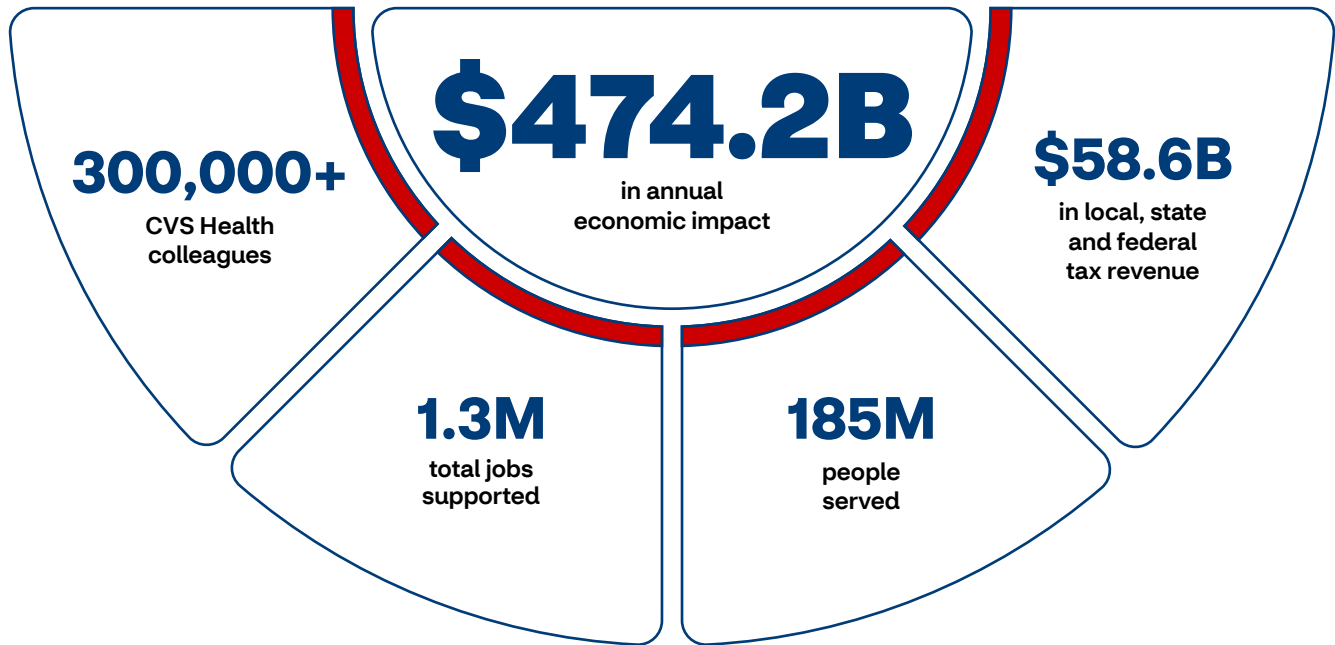

With over 9,000 locations and more than 300,000 employees nationwide, CVS Health is a driving force in the American economy, contributing \$474.2 billion in economic impact.

Economic Impact

CVS Health's operations in the United States generated an economic impact of \$474.2 billion. This includes a direct impact of \$286.4 billion, \$105.8 billion indirect and \$82 billion induced impact in FY24.

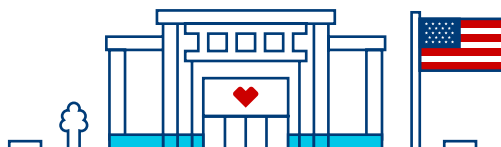

Supporting and Sustaining Jobs

Overall, CVS Health supported nearly 1.3 million jobs (1,285,758) throughout the more than 9,000 CVS Health locations (410,940 direct, 485,963 indirect and 388,855 induced) in FY24.

Contributing to the Local, State and Federal Tax Base

CVS Health supported \$58.6 billion in federal, state and local taxes in the United States as a result of operations and capital spending in FY24. Federal (\$25.3 billion), state (\$17.4 billion) and local taxes (\$15.9 billion) include payroll taxes, income taxes (when assessed), sales taxes and unemployment taxes.

Methodology

The study is a snapshot of economic impact as of December 31, 2024, unless otherwise noted. Data used to complete the economic analysis was provided by CVS Health. Data supplied included operating expenditures, capital spending, pay and benefits, direct taxes paid and total employees. The colleague data used in the analysis of the report represents the sum total of all colleagues who were in the country at any time in 2024. Average number of CVS Health colleagues reflects a point-in-time estimate in 2024. Primary and secondary data was used to complete the input-output models in IMPLAN. Additional jobs include indirect employment created as a result of CVS Health's economic impact and induced employment as a result of household spending by CVS Health employees and employees of vendors. The CVS Health colleague and location data is as of January 1, 2025. Numbers in this report are subject to rounding.
